# Three things **You** can do to share Christ naturally:

---

## 1. You must yearn for the things of God.

- You can't witness what you have not experienced.
- You will discover the things of God through worship, Bible Study, and prayer.
- Join a small group ministry.
- You must not negotiate time with God. The secret to Jesus' witness was His time spent in God's presence.
- Continual preparation is the hinge, that opens the door to God's revelation.
- God cares about people, so pray for the lost daily and for the same burden He has.

## 2. You must reflect obedient love at all times.

- Obedient love is the key to effectively witnessing for Jesus.
- Obligation will only lead to mechanical perception, but acts of humility and love tell others that you have a genuine concern for them.
- **Perform** 3 to 5 acts of humble service everyday.
- Look for opportunities daily, as the Spirit compels you to interact with OTHERS .
- A phone call, a letter, a card, a personal need met, etc.  
Doing is the model Jesus left us to follow.

“Each one should use whatever gift he

## 3. You must use your life for God’s glory.

- Prioritize your life values.
- You must utilize your time, talent, treasure and testimony for God’s glory -- not yours.
- Be involved in visible ministry.
- Invest your life in OTHERS.
- Pray that God will use you to share your story of faith.
- Intentionally invite someone to worship weekly.
- Show people Christ-like love in all segments of your life. In word and deed.
